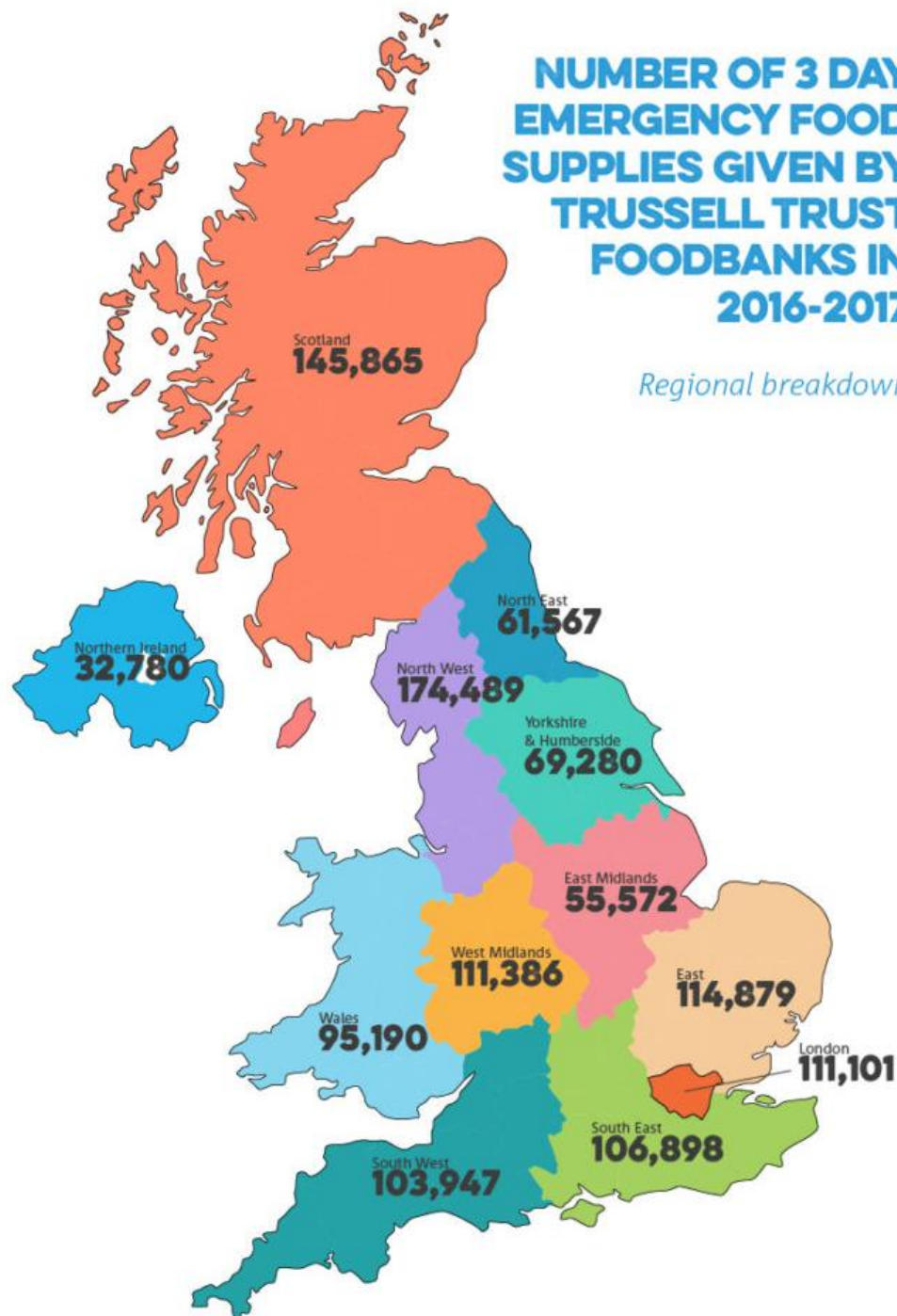

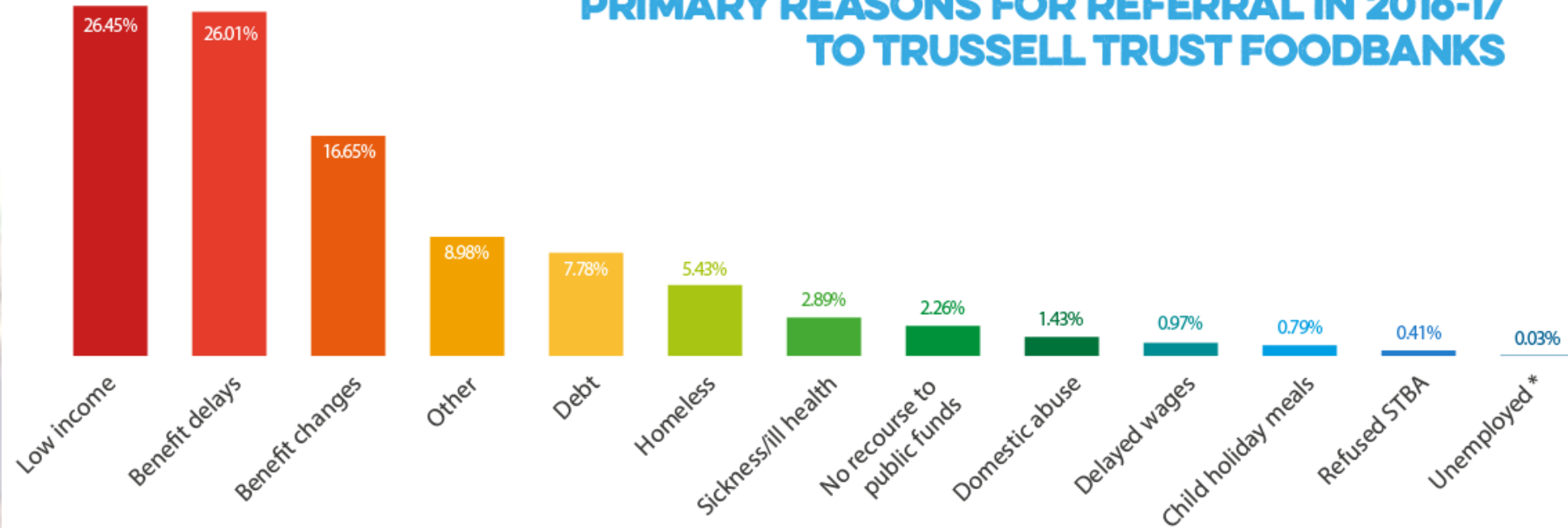

\* This shows data from 1 April to 5 May 2016 when it stopped being recorded as a main crisis cause





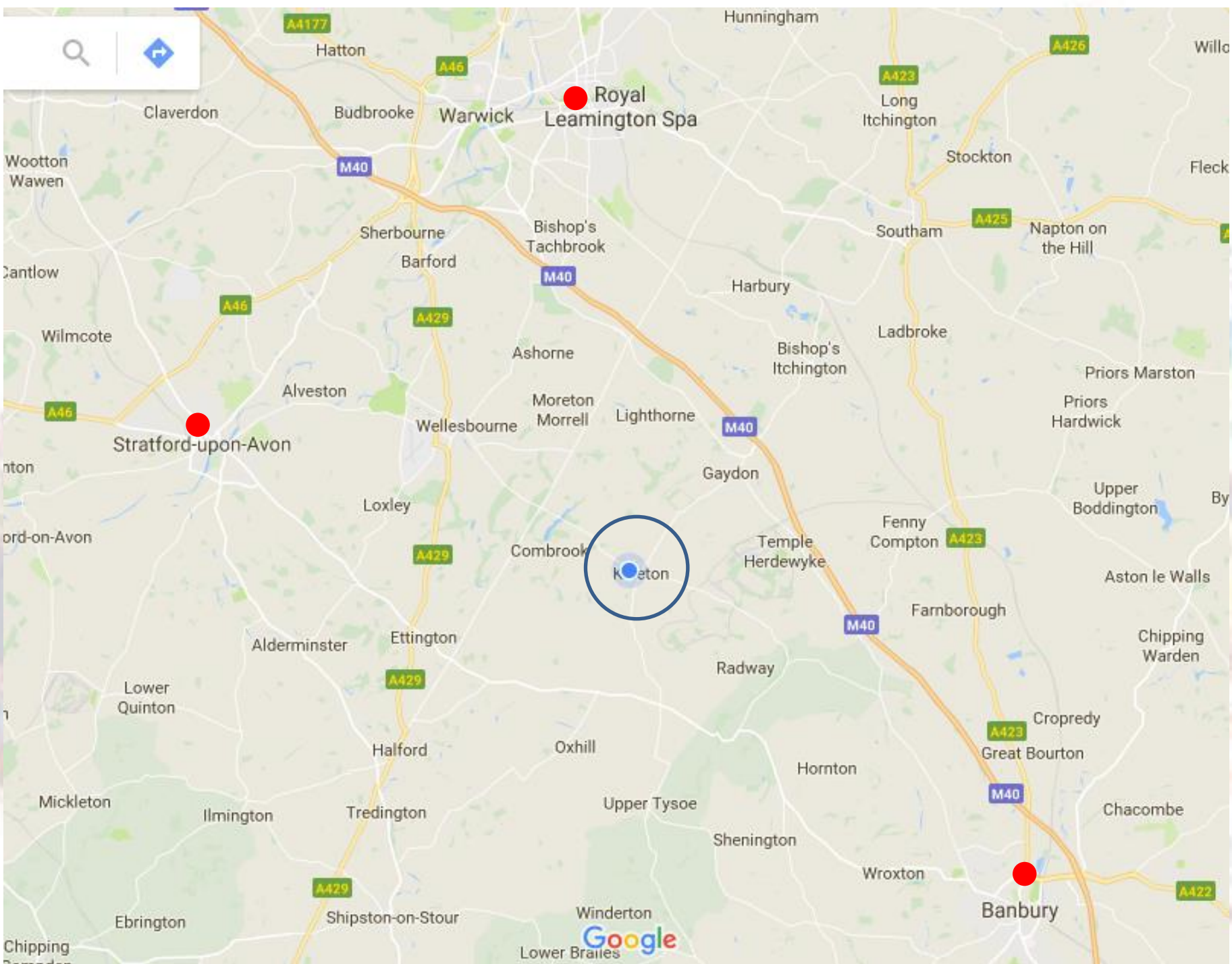


# Why a rural foodbank?



# ***Rural Poverty?***

- ***Cost of living for family of 4 up to £10k higher than urban***
- ***Fuel Poverty at 28% vs. 18% in urban***
- ***Travel costs more than double for low earners***
- ***Rural inflation 7.7% in 2011 (UK avg of 4.7%)***

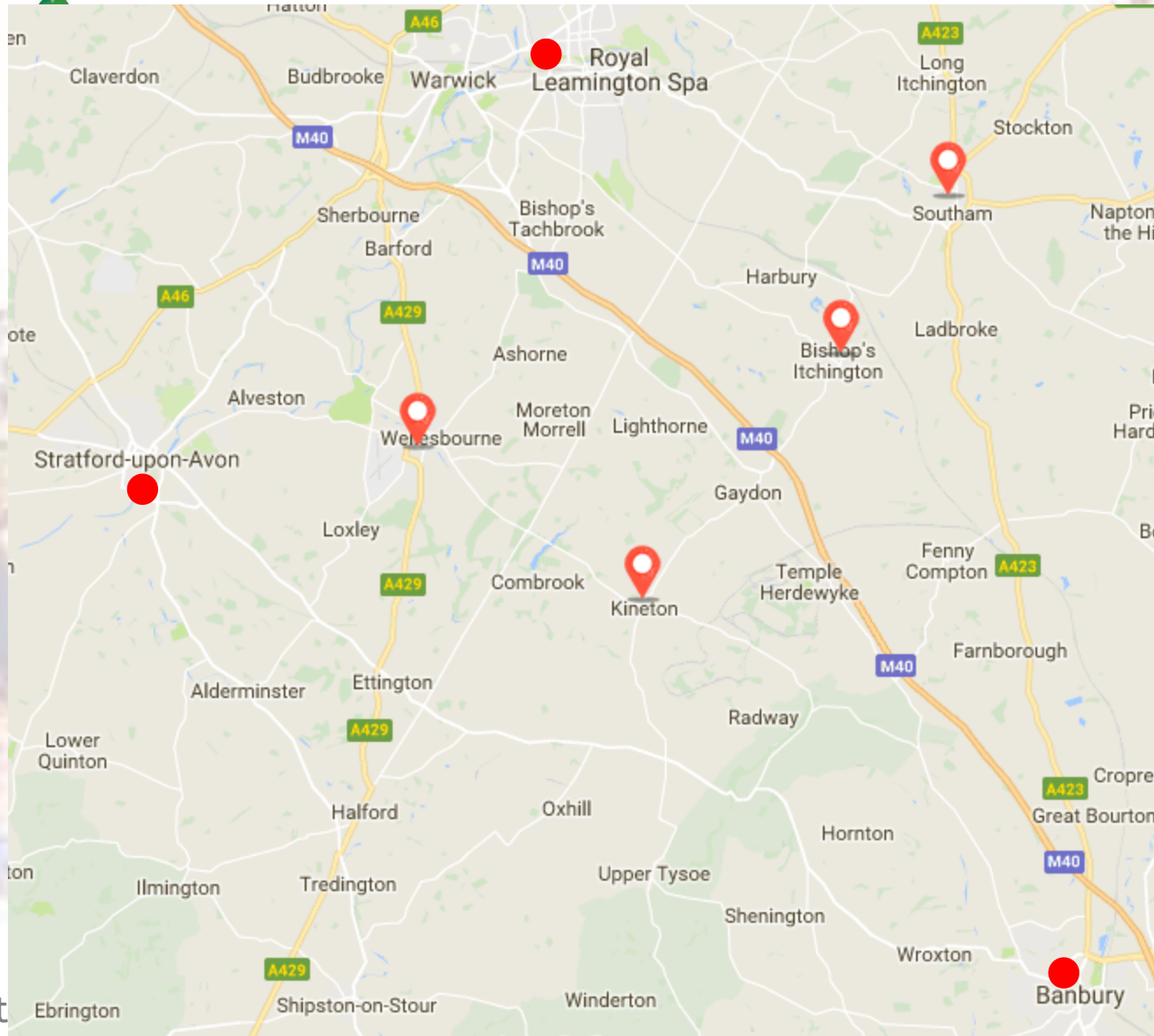

***A Delivery  
System for

transport***



***Agencies  
identify  
someone in  
need and call  
the nearest  
foodbank***



***The  
foodbank  
takes the  
client details  
and fills in a  
voucher***





***The foodbank  
phones the client  
to see if they can  
make it to the  
distribution  
centre or if they  
need delivery***



***If needed two  
members of the  
delivery team,  
take an  
Emergency  
Foodbox round  
to the client***



***The delivery team unpack the box and check things off with the client and provide any signposting requested***



***The box is  
returned to the  
distribution  
centre to be  
re-filled the  
next time the  
centre is open***

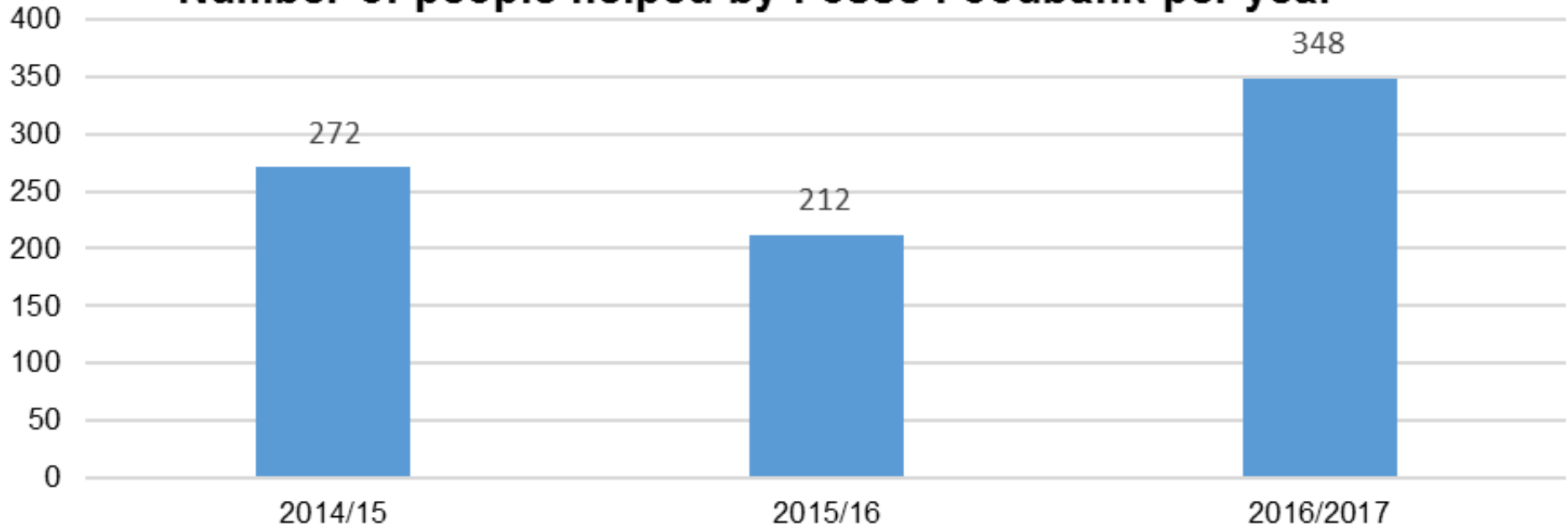

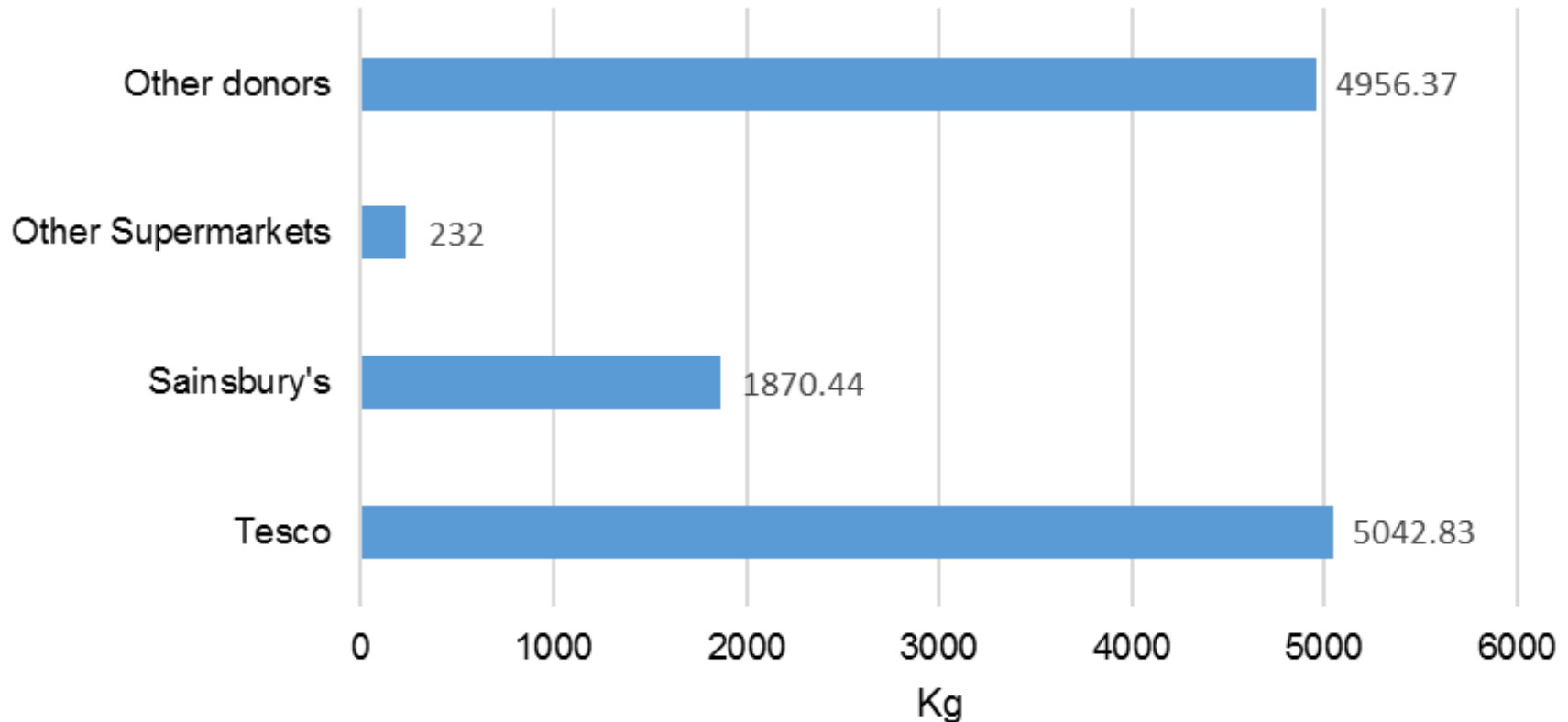
