


The Learning Community

in mission (fruits)


supported by:

- Theological reflection (branches)




Christian practices (roots)

Enabling structures (trunk)


- Mission fund hosted by 'Resource Church'

Theological Reflection (branches)

The Pastoral Cycle

- 1) Name the experience
What is happening?
- 2) Look at the wider information and implications
Why is it happening?
- 3) Where is God in the experience?
What does it mean?
- 4) Bringing change
How shall we respond?

Maturing disciples involved in mission (fruit)

1. Growing younger
2. Going on growing in later life
3. Creative arts to explore and share the Christian story
4. Social action for the common good
5. Supporting whole life discipleship

Investing in people

- Sessional posts
 - School Chaplain (3 hours a week paid)
 - Artist-in-residence (unpaid)
 - Administrator (additional hours - paid)
 - Going on Growing Chaplain (unpaid)
 - Music Chaplain (paid)
- Training (eg. Godly Play, The Spiritual Exercises)
- Resources (eg. new hymn books, display boards)

Plant for tomorrow?



Early Steps

- Team Vicar's post became 100% Missioner
- Reader-in-Charge of 4 rural parishes
- NSM Priest in charge of 2 rural parishes
- PTO colleagues
- Raise money (pour on nutrients)
 - Legacy and local fund raising
 - Grant-making trusts
- House-for-duty stipend invested in lay ministry

Emerging Lessons

- Build upon existing learning and experience
- Release the energy of God's people
- Fragile, vulnerable
- Messy, individual, particular
- Collaboration
